

LINUS Express Entry


The new Express Entry feature in LINUS will allow users to start tracking multiple bills at one time. The users will have the option to populate the following fields during this process: Division, Office, Bill Manager (with Primary checkbox), Receive Email Updates and Receive Email Group Updates. Please follow the instructions below to begin using this new feature.

To start tracking multiple bills at one time:

1. On the Bill Search screen, select “Untracked” or “(all bills)” in the Tracked drop-down and enter any additional search criteria to narrow your search.

Note: By default, searching by “Untracked” will filter out bills already tracked by the agency. However, the results will vary if you have selected a division or office. If you search by a division, all bills **not** tracked by the selected division and by offices within that division will be returned. If you search by an office, all bills **not** tracked by the selected office will be returned.

2. Click the **Search Now** button.


