¹Functional unit managers may develop additional criteria within the framework of these matrices to manage services and privileges specific to the institution (e.g., waiting lists).

²Inmates transferring to minimum security facilities will be placed at the appropriate incentive level based upon their institutional history. These inmates will retain personal property and canteen spending limits earned prior to the transfer.

³An inmate whose incentive level has been reduced one level as a result of a disciplinary sanction will be considered as meeting the all eligibility criteria of the reduced incentive level. *(For example, an inmate who receives a disciplinary sanction of seven days segregation and whose incentive level is reduced from a Level III to a Level II will be considered as meeting all the eligibility criteria for a Level II.)*
