



Required Furlough Days During the 2011-2013 Biennium and Offices of the Oregon Department of Forestry

Coping with reduced state revenues continues to require closing most state offices and facilities on certain days throughout the remainder of 2011, 2012, and the beginning of 2013. As an emergency response agency, the Oregon Department of Forestry will **not observe most of those required state agency furlough days** that result in agency closures. Oregon Department of Forestry offices will **remain open for business** for the majority of mandatory state agency furlough days, **with the exception of the day following Thanksgiving in both 2011 and 2012.**

Oregon Department of Forestry employees are still required to take the same number of unpaid furlough days as all other state employees; however, those days will be spread throughout the biennium (referred to as "floating furlough days"), at the decision of the employees and their supervisors, as opposed to being required on mandatory state agency furlough closure days.
